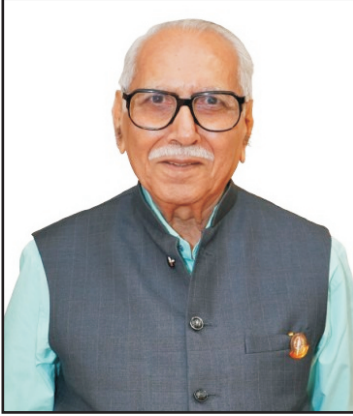

Built - Not born

From a Village Dream to a National Legacy : The Inspiring Journey of CA Mohanlal Ghewarchand Bhandari



Humble Beginnings and Early Belief

A small village called Somesar in Rajasthan, a young boy once dared to dream beyond the boundaries of a traditional family business. That boy, CA Mohanlal Ghewarchand Bhandari, would

go on to build one of India's most respected audit and advisory firms, proving that ambition, when backed by discipline and integrity, can redefine destiny. Born into a modest background, his family saw potential in him long before the world did. "You can do much more than this," they told him, encouraging him to pursue Chartered Accountancy. That belief became his foundation. With determination and focus, he secured All India Rank 22 in CA Inter and Rank 49 in CA Final, setting the stage for a larger journey.

Facing Reality in Mumbai

When he moved to Mumbai, reality tested him. Staying in a godown, struggling with English as a Hindi-medium student, and facing repeated rejections, the odds were not in his favor. At one firm, he was told, "You can join only if you can write in Gujarati." Instead of stepping back, he stepped forward. After three days of learning, he returned and confidently said, "Hu likhu sakhu chu Gujarati ma." That moment changed everything. It was not just about language. It was about a mindset that quietly says, "I will find a way."

The Learning Years

His articleship years became his real classroom. Each firm he worked with shaped his thinking, discipline, and technical strength. When offered a comfortable partnership, he made a bold choice. "If I have to build something, I will build it myself." In 1979, with just a small table space, MGB & Co. was born.

Building from the Ground Up

The early years were not easy. There were financial constraints, uncertainty, and long hours of hard work. But he believed in consistency over shortcuts. Slowly, opportunities followed preparation. A defining moment came when a major corporate client placed their trust in him. That trust opened new doors. With each assignment, his credibility grew. From helping companies get listed on stock exchanges to securing rare licenses that others thought impossible, he built a reputation grounded in knowledge and persistence.

Perseverance in the Face of Challenges

When faced with rejection during a critical licensing project, many would have stopped. Instead, he chose to persist. "If it is right, it is worth fighting for," he believed. The eventual success became a milestone, proving that perseverance often turns impossibility into achievement.

Evolving Definition of Success

Over time, his definition of success evolved. "Earlier, success meant survival," he reflects. "Today, it means building systems that last beyond you." At the core of his journey lies an unwavering commitment to ethics. "I have never chosen the wrong path, even when it was easier," he says. That single principle earned him trust across clients, institutions, and government authorities.

Values that Define Success

His journey teaches a powerful lesson. "Skills may open doors, but values keep them open." Beyond professional achievements, what brings him the greatest satisfaction is impact. Seeing businesses grow responsibly and knowing that his work contributes to the nation's economy gives deeper meaning to his success.

Lifesaving Mission Continues : 113th Blood Donation Drive

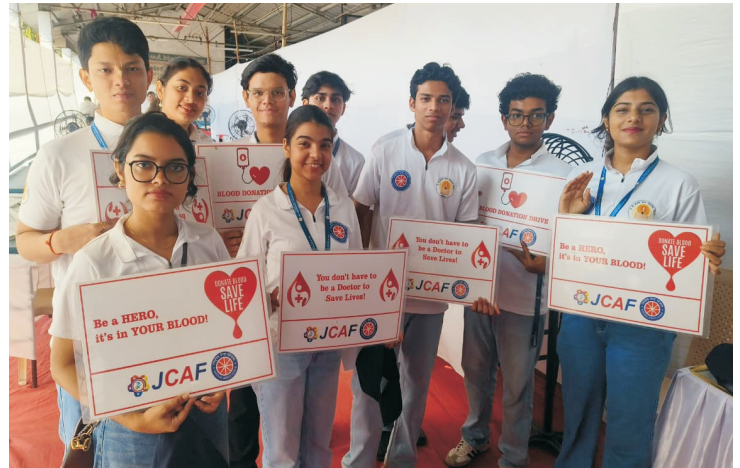

The second and concluding session of the insightful series by Shri Manish Modi on the Four Bhāvanās brought a deeply enriching spiritual journey to a meaningful close.

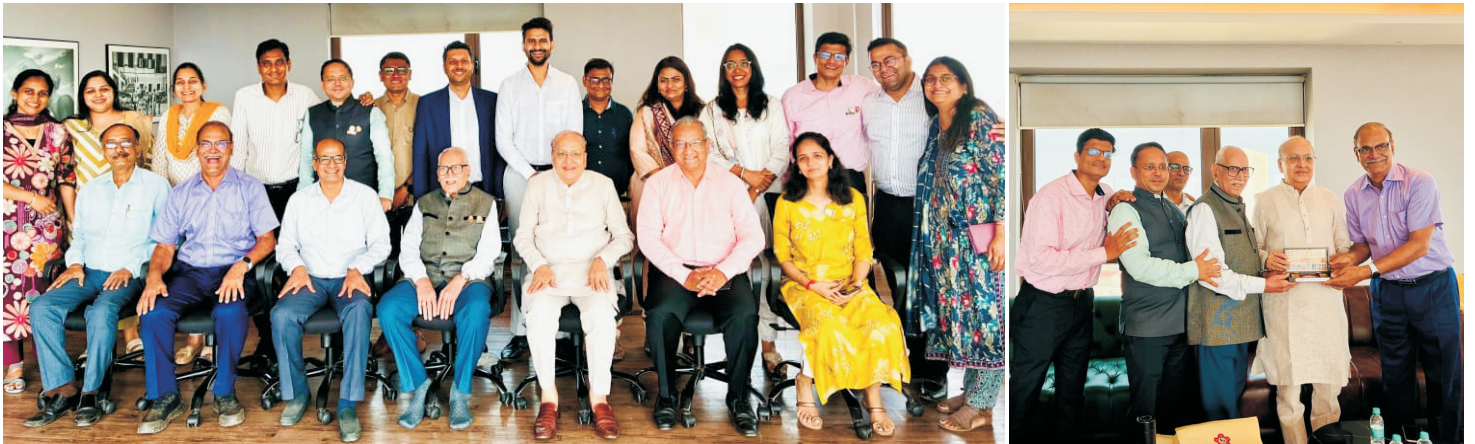

हंसते - हंसते जीवन जिए

अंग्रेजी में क कहावत है, जिसका अर्थ है कि प्रतिदिन केवल तीन बार खिल-खिला कर हंसने वाला मनुष्य न रोगी होता है, न उसे किसी चिकित्सक की जरूरत होती है। डॉ होम्स का कथन है - प्रसन्नता परमात्मा की दी हुई औषधि है। आवश्यकता से अधिक चिंता जीवन का कूड़ा है, उसे दूर करने के लिए हास्य की नितांत आवश्यकता है। स्लेटर का कहना है - मुस्कुराहट पर आपका कुछ खर्च नहीं होता है, परंतु उससे बहुत कुछ प्राप्त होता है, इसे पाने वाला मालामाल हो जाता है और देने वाले की जेब से कुछ भी खर्च नहीं होता है। मुस्कुराहट एक क्षण में पैदा होती है पर उसकी मधुर स्मृति कभी - कभी तो सदा के लिए मस्तिष्क पर अंकित हो जाती है।

सफलता के नवरत्नों में यह भी एक रत्न है कि सदा मुस्कुराहट को अपने होठों पर बनाए रखें, यह देने पर तुरंत सफलता मिल जाती है। मुस्कुराहट एक ऐसा मनोवैज्ञानिक आसन है, जिससे मन के तार - तार झंकृत हो जाते हैं और यहां विद्यमान ईर्ष्या, द्वेष, कुटिलता, दुर्भाव और तनाव दूर हो जाता है। परेशानियों का निवारण का परीक्षित उपाय है - मधुर मुस्कुराहट

डॉक्टर प्रोफेसर नॉर्मन का कथन है की - हंसना एक उत्तम व्यायाम है। प्रतिदिन चार-पांच किलोमीटर दौड़ने से जो शारीरिक क्षमता बढ़ती है उतनी क्षमता ५ मिनट हंसने से बढ़ जाती है। हंसने से शरीर के स्नायुओं को स्वतः व्यायाम करने का मौका मिलता है, इससे शारीरिक और मानसिक वेदनाओं में कमी आ जाती है। जोर से हंसने से रक्त संचालन स्वाभाविक रूप से होता है। उन्मुक्त हंसी प्रतिरोधक तंत्र की ताकत में वृद्धि करती है।

जो नित्य मुस्कुराता रहता है उसके तनाव, भय, निराशा, चिंता, नकारात्मक सोच, क्रोध, घृणा आदि स्वतः दूर होने लगते हैं। मुख मंडल आभा से प्रदीप्त रहता है। व्यक्ति का व्यक्तित्व निखरता है। जिसके चेहरे पर कितनी ज्यादा मुस्कान रहती है, उसका स्वास्थ्य उतना ही अधिक अच्छा रहता है। मुस्कुराना प्रकृति की मानव को अनुपम देना है। जो उसको स्वास्थ्य, सुखी, प्रसन्नचित रखने का उसके स्वयं के हाथ में सहज, सरल, सस्ता, सभी समय में उपलब्ध प्रभावशाली उपाय है। जिसमें किसी भी प्रकार के दुष्प्रभाव की संभावना नहीं है। जितना अधिक व्यक्ति आंतरिक मुस्कुराहट से ओतपोत रहता है, उतनी ही उसकी सहनशीलता बढ़ती जाती है। प्रतिकूलता और वियोग में वह समतामय जीवन जी सकता है। उसकी पर दोष दृष्टि समाप्त होने लगती है। चिंतन सकारात्मक होने लगता है। सकारात्मक भावों से शरीर के लिए उपयोग रसायन पैदा होने लगते हैं, कार्य क्षमता बढ़ जाती है।

जब मुस्कान हंसी में बदल जाती है तो स्वास्थ्यवर्धक औषधि का कार्य करने लगती है। शरीर में विद्यमान विजातीय तत्वों को विसर्जित करने तथा शवसन के विभिन्न व्यायामों में हास्य-योग सरलतम नैसर्गिक क्रिया है। हास्य योग अर्थात् खुलकर हंसना। हास्य तनाव का विरेचन है। सच्चा हास्य तोप की गोले की तरह छूटता है और मायूसी की चट्टान को बिखेर देता है। हास्य से रोम-रोम पुलकित होते हैं, दुःखों का विस्मरण होता है खून में नयी चेतना आती है। हंसी से शरीर में ताजगी आती है। खुली हवा में स्वच्छ वातावरण में हंसने से शरीर में वेग के साथ ऑक्सिजन का अधिक संचार होने से मांसपेशियां सख्त होती हैं। जमे हुए विजातीय अनुपयोगी अनावश्यक तत्व अपना स्थान छोड़ने लगते हैं, जिससे विशेष रूप से फेफड़े और हृदय की कार्य क्षमता बढ़ती है। अवरोध समाप्त होने से रक्त का प्रभाव संतुलित होने लगता है। शरीर स्वस्थ आए एवं बलिष्ठ होने लगता है। स्वाभाविक निद्रा आती है। बुखार दूर हो जाता है। वास्तव में हंसी सभी प्रकार के रोगों में प्रायः लाभकारी है। व्यक्ति दवाओं की दासता से मुक्त हो सकता है।

प्रातःकाल खाली पेट मुंह बंद कर खुली हवा में स्वच्छ वातावरण में मन ही मन तीव्र गति से हंसने का प्रयास करें, जिससे हास्य योग का लाभ मिल सकता है। प्रातःकाल उदित सूर्य के सामने, हास्य व्यायाम अधिक प्रभावशाली होता है क्योंकि इसमें हास्य लाभ के साथ सौर-ऊर्जा की भी सहज प्राप्ति हो जाती है।

उपहास या मजाक के रूप में हंसना, किसी की असफलता या नुकसान पर हंसना क्रूर हास्य है। कर्म बंध का कारण है। अतः ऐसे हास्य का निषेध है। परंतु में होंठ बंद कर शांत हंसी कषाय वृद्धि का कारण भी नहीं होती है। अतः सभी स्तर के व्यक्ति वेहिकक नियमित सभी परिस्थितियों में ऐसे हास्य योग को कर सकते हैं। होठों की हल्की हंसी और प्यार भरे शब्द किसी को इतना सुख दे सकते हैं, जितना की हजारों रुपए खर्च करने पर भी नहीं मिल सकता है। हंसता चेहरा सबको प्रिय लगता है, हंसने वाला स्वयं तो प्रसन्न दिखता ही है औरों को भी प्रसन्नता से भर देता है। बड़े से बड़े संकट हंसते हुए साहस के साथ झेलिए आपकी मुसीबत व परेशानी आधी रह जाएगी। तनाव के क्षणों में महात्मा गांधी मजाक करने से बाज नहीं आते थे। उनका कहना था - यदि वो हंसना नहीं जानते तो कब से पागल हो जाते। कहा भी है।

हंसते हंसाते जीवने जीते रहिए।

जिंदगी एक मेला है मुस्कुराते रहिए।
